



Serving on a PAAR Committee: Frequently Asked Questions

Why should I serve on a committee?

PAAR's committees are a great forum for debate and discussion. Being on a committee allows you to contribute to the decision-making process and ensure that the association has input from members in order to best serve their needs.

How can I apply to a committee?

Applying to a committee is simple. Applications open in the fall and will be available online at paar.org. Check your inbox for an email announcing when applications open.

Do I have to be a member of PAAR to serve on a committee?

Yes, committee service is a member benefit.

How long are committee terms?

All committee appointments are for one year with the exception of the Multiple Listing Service committee, which is a two-year term.

What are the criteria to serve on a committee?

Active PAAR members may serve on committees. However, some committees have further criteria that must be met. For example, the Affiliate Council is only open for Affiliate members to join. Read each committee description to learn more.

Can I choose the committee I want to serve on?

When applying, you will have the opportunity to select your choice of committees.

If I apply, am I automatically on that committee?

Not necessarily. Final committee selections are at the discretion of the Board of Directors.

What is the role of the Board Liaison for the committee?

A member of the Board of Directors is assigned to each committee to act as a representative of that committee at meetings of the Board of Directors.

Do committees meet via conference call or in person?

Committees may meet in person or virtually, depending on the committee.
